EFFECT/AFFECT	Both can be verbs; only the former is a noun
COMMITTEE	Two 'Ms' and two 'Ts' please
IMPLEMENT	Not IMPLIMENT
INDEPENDENT	Not INDEPENDANT
GOVERNMENT	Not GOVERMENT
SEPARATE	Not SEPERATE
ARGUMENT	No 'E' between the 'U' and the 'M'
PRINCIPLE/PRINCIPAL	The former is a noun, the latter is typically an adjective
ACCOMMODATE	Two 'Cs' and two 'Ms'
COMPARATIVE	Not COMPARITIVE
PRIMITIVE	Not PRIMATIVE
COMMITTED	Two 'Ts'
COMMITMENT	One 'T'
AGGRESSION	Two 'Gs'
PARLIAMENT	Not PARLIMENT
INSIGHTFUL	Not INSITEFUL
DOMINANT/DOMINATE	The former is an adjective, the latter a verb
TENETS/TENANTS	The former means 'principles', the latter means a renter or occupant
BUSINESS	Not BUSSINESS
LEGITIMATE	Not LEGITAMATE
PROFESSION(AL)	One 'F'
DILEMMA	One 'L'
ENHANCE	Not INHANCE
INPUT	Not IMPUT
ALIENATE	Not ALIANATE
BENNETT	Two 'Ns' and two 'Ts'
